AWARDS PRESENTATION - CROSSING EUROPE Film Festival Linz 2014

The presentation of awards in the eleventh CROSSING EUROPE Film Festival Linz took place today in the Ursulinensaal in the Upper Austrian Culture Quarter. The evening was moderated by Markus Zett, and Tanja Brüggemann-Stepien provided a fascinating sound experience. With numerous international film guests, representatives from the industry and the press present, as well as representatives of the funders and sponsors, and from politics – including members of the Provincial Government Elisabeth Manhal and Josef Ackerl, Vice-Mayor and Speaker for Culture Bernhard Baier, and Mayor Klaus Luger – the CROSSING EUROPE AWARDS were presented, and Festival Director Christine Dollhofer reported first positive results from the festival.

The Local Artists jury [Brigitta Burger-Utzer (AT), Sebastian Höglinger (AT), Sabine Retschitzegger (AT)] stated: "The Local Artist Award 2014 goes to a film that stands out in its formal consistency; a film that demands relentless concentration from the audience. Memories of a day in the Bosnian war are meanderingly woven into a verbal image. The text level is actually inscribed in the film picture, sometimes overwrites it, and its physical presence rejects any aestheticization of what is remembered. In keeping with this, the sound remains silent. Specifically this de-dramatization of the events, however, allows an inkling of the trauma that is never named as such."

The director pays tribute to the energy, courage, audacity and determination of her protagonists, who have to resist patriarchal structures as well as to stand their ground as women in the dangerous time of revolutionary upheavals in Egypt.”
